- The 6th Copernicus Olympiad will have only 4 disciplines: Natural Science Olympiad, Physics & Astronomy Olympiad, Copernicus Entrepreneurship Olympiad (CEO), and Mathematics Olympiad.
- Preliminary Round registration deadlines are 3 days before the exam date. No other applications will be accepted after that.
- Each country that registers 1000+ students for the Preliminary Round will be given one extra scholarship for free participation from that country.
- The official exam languages of the Copernicus Olympiad are English, Russian, French, and Spanish. Exams will be provided in these four languages.
- The syllabus is provided on our [website](#) under the Olympiad menu.
- The registration fees for the Preliminary Round are non-refundable.
- Some countries will take the exam on paper in their country rather than online on the Copernicus Platform. It is the contestants' responsibility to check with their country representative if the exam is online or on paper.
- Check [here](#) to see if Copernicus Olympiad has a representative in your country.
- Absolute winners of all categories will participate in the Global Round for free.
- To qualify for the Global Round, contestants must score 40% or higher in the Preliminary Round exam.
- IMO, IBO, IPhO, and IChO medalists can participate directly in the Global Round without taking the Preliminary Round.
- Each Global Round has a quota of 1000 seats.
- All contestants, their guests, and supervisors must read the [Refund Policy](#) of the company before applying for the Global Round.
- Each contestant can invite a maximum of 2 guests for the Global Round.
- Each country partner must provide one chaperone for every 10 contestants during the Global Round.
- Global Round seats will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Contestants cannot participate in the Global Round if the quota is full, even if they are qualified to participate.
- Optional tours have limited seats and will be provided to those who book first.
